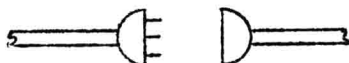

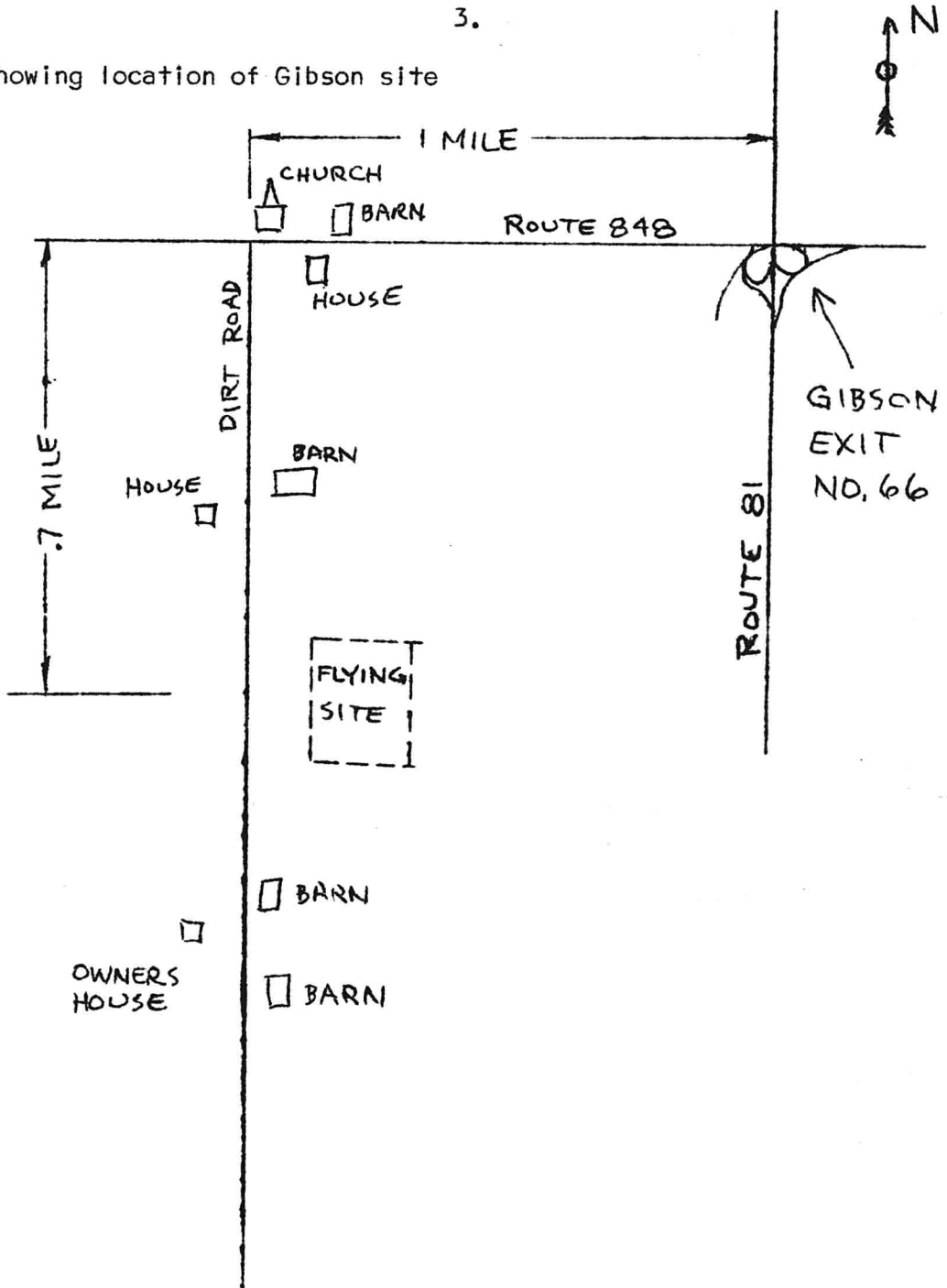
TECHNICAL NOTE

Sound level measurements were made at the club field using the Ham Shack sound level meter which the club purchased recently. All measurements were made with the airplane on the ground (grass surface). The plane was rotated at a distance of 20 ft. from the sound level meter until a maximum reading was obtained.
