Review of 1974

Our expenditures were greater than any other administration, with the exception of the year our present field was purchased. This was due to the purchase of our new mower, permanent setup of our storage trailer and grading and seeding of the Hodges site.

On the plus side, with some luck and repeated negotiations, we recovered the full cost of our old storage building. We also received some income from a flying demonstration and realized some profit from the 1974 annual dinner. The 1974 Pattern and Scale contest made 2 1/2 times as much profit as any previous contest and resulted in doubling the money in our new field account. This is a record that we can be proud of and it should serve as a goal for future administrations to shoot at.
