#### Aero Guidance Society Meeting # 793

November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013

Place: Endicott Public Library

President Allabaugh called the meeting to order at 6:44 PM.

Guests: None

Minutes of last meeting: Accepted as published in The Connector.

Minutes of last board meeting: A synopsis was read by secretary, Bob Noll.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Todd gave no report but mentioned that he is collecting dues. He also provided those members who paid their dues at the meeting the club stickers for their AMA cards.

#### Committee Reports:

<u>Field</u> – Jim Quinn reminded everyone that the field winterizing work party is scheduled for 12 noon on Saturday November 9. Rick said that hot dogs, and cold and warm beverages will be provided. A donation can will be there so there is no cost to the club.
