The annual meeting for electing officers of the Aeroguidance Society will be held Friday, February 2 at 8:00 pm in the Hooper School. All members are urged to attend.

A nominating committee, appointed by the president, will present a slate of officers. A nominating committee is commonly used by organizations such as ours in order to insure that there is at least one willing and qualified candidate for each office. There is no intention to restrict the number of candidates, and members are encouraged to make nominations from the floor.

FROM THE AMA MONTHLY MAILING

As a result of the great magazine controversy, the AMA is considering a number of possibilities for publications. They also are studying a new membership concept which is interesting. The concept includes the following:

- 1. A basic membership fee for general services, including insurance.
- 2. An additional fee to cover competition services (license to enter sanctioned competition, rule book, competition newsletter subscription).
- An additional fee to provide a choice of various AMA news publications.
- 4. A discount on the basic membership fee to members of chartered clubs, on the basis that the club would provide the roster of members so that little or no HQ effort would be required for file maintenance relating to members.

The concept would provide for a basic fee, probably \$5, to club members; more (perhaps \$6) to non-club members. The competition service fee might be an additional \$3 or \$6 depending upon whether the Competition Newsletter is automatically included. The choices of general AMA news publications might include a commercial magazine or a reprint of the AMA news from same, with price to vary accordingly. Or the choice might be whether or not to subscribe to an AMA-only publication.
