FROM THE DCRC NEWSLETTER:

This is from the March DCRC newsletter wich contained a brief exerpt of a talk given ata DCRC meeting by Frank Garcher of Midwest Products.

"Our guest speaker was Frank Garcher of Midwest. He showed a fine selection of slides taken in Equador, the source of our balsa supplies. In a most entertaining presentation, he made a good case for the present high cost of our precious balsa, which, he says, grows like a weed in Equador so there is no danger - ever - of running short.

A forest can be completely cut and, without any help from man, the balsa grows back again so that in as little as seven years you have your forest of balsa again, ready for harvesting, However, the fact that only 15 percent of an average log produces balsa of a quality for our purposes, added to ever-increasing production costs, means that the price is going - where else - up, up and away. On the subject of complaints about the quality of the "Pitts" kit, he was equally entertaining, though somewhat less convincing."
