Program


Program Chairman Guillermo Leon opened tonight's program on Winter Skis by Terry Terrenoire. Highlights of the program include:

Floats need to be rigidly attached with no movement. Skis do not have the same requirement.


Skis can be made using a variety of materials, fiberglass, Plexiglas, plywood using a template made from a piece of rigid material like a piece of 2x4.

How big? Trial and Error. Need to trim to desired function. Fluffy snow need larger skis, dense snow need smaller skis.

Recheck CG balance once skis have been installed on the plane. Recommended that weight associated with balance of the skis on the ski.
