AGS General Meeting Minutes November 7, 2011

Meeting No. 769, called to order by Terry Terrenoire at 6:45PM.

Visitor: Dave Roberts.

Minutes for Oct 3 meeting – The scheduled date for the Pylon Racers helpers party was announced by Jim Quinn not Terry Terrenoire. Don Green made a motion to accept the minutes as corrected. Seconded by Doug Breneman. Motion approved.

Bob Johnson gave the Treasurer's monthly financial report.

Terry Terrenoire gave a report on the pylon race season:

Only 6 races held.

3rd place: Jim Quinn

2nd place: Don Shugard

1st place: Nationwide Champion, Jeff Hatton

Sprint Competition Champion – Bob Noll

Terry Terrenoire: Acknowledged Paul Slocum's resignation as president, due to health issues. We should have had discussion on nomination of officers at September meeting but this was not done for a variety of reasons. Nominations are as follows:

Bob Johnson – Treasurer, second term.

John Carril – Secretary, second term.

Ed Lancki – Vice-President.

Vern Ziegler – Board Member at Large

New President – need candidates. Asked for nominations, none submitted.

ACTION: The Board must nominate and elect

Nominations must be posted in Connector.

Bob Thomson made a motion for the Secretary to cast a single vote for all nominees; seconded by Mark Lecher. Motion was carried and all nominees were elected.

A discussion was held on Terry Terrenoire's proposals for converting the two club trainers to electric or 2.4 MHz, or selling them. Scott Wallace disagreed, proposing that they be left as is and stored for future use for events. It was agreed that that they should be left as is and stored. Scott Wallace and John Carril each agreed to store one of them.

Winter Fly – John Carril is to get insurance certificate for

BC United field for one year (extended period) instead of just three months, since the field is available for a longer period.

Doug Breneman has agreed to store 3 pounds of frozen Sabrett hot dogs for the club.

A discussion was held about the possibility of holding a club auction, tentatively March 31/2012. Potential sites are the Endicott Elks and the West Corners firehouse. Terry and Jim will look into the firehouse availability. Scott Wallace may be available to run it.

Program:

Bob Johnson gave a presentation on inexpensive flight simulators providing comparisons of features and cost.

Show and Tell:

Bob Noll showed his Skybolt Sport scale biplane that earned 3rd place in the Nationals. The model's design is based on the full scale version that Scott Wallace's father built. Afterwards, Bob presented the plane to Scott Wallace.

Doug Breneman showed a Harbor Freight aluminum case (Model 39196) that he purchased for \$19.99 (reg. price \$29.99 but was on sale for \$24.99 less 4.98 with their 20% coupon). It measures 18"x12-3/4"x6" and will accommodate two transmitters. It has 1-inch foam in the lid and 2-inches in the bottom, multiple dividers, a removal tool pocket, a carry strap and two keyed locks (that he said don't lock anything).

Jeff Hatton showed a Dynex kit that he purchased for \$30 to replace his Foresight and only weighs 1.2 oz.

Ed Lancki showed a battery tester that he purchased from Heads Up RC for \$6.

Terry Terrenoire - showed his Tough Flite that he built from a kit (\$65). He reported that it flies very nicely. He also showed a pair of gloves he purchased that have the ability to expose your thumbs and index fingers. Terry also reported that he ordered six lithium polymer transmitter battery backs and has sold five of them.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:30 PM.

Don't Forget the Annual Holiday Party

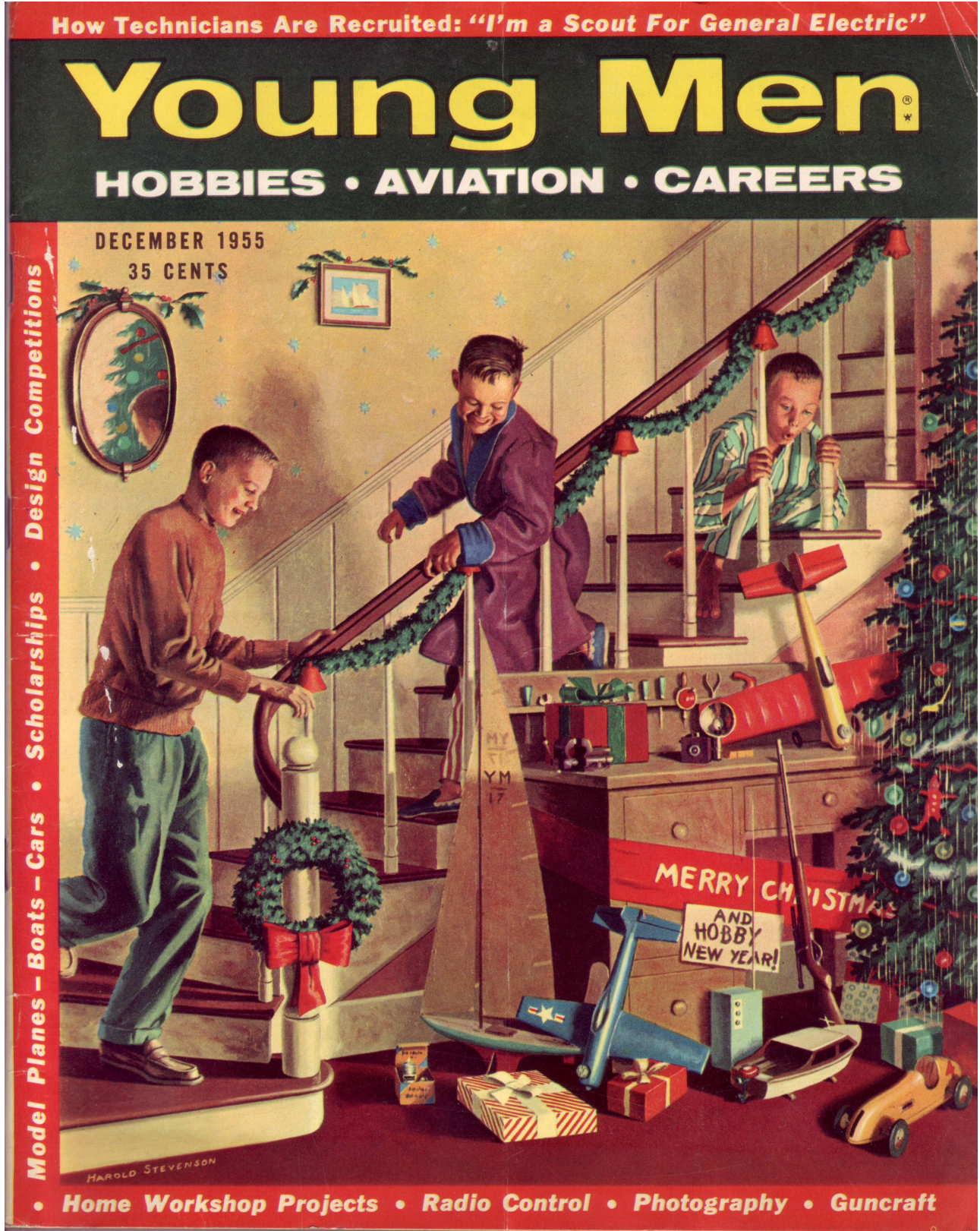
