## *NOTE:* 72 MHz Channel #42 Must Not Be Used at the AGS Field

What was the first RC related Christmas present you can remember receiving? In my case, it was 1969 and my dad gave me a shiny new Enya 15 in the fragile clear plastic box they used to come in. It was a control line engine, and I flew that for many years and learned it's almost impossible to kill an Enya despite numerous crashes. Years later, I replaced the venturi with an RC carburetor and kept using this engine on small RC models for many more years. I used Enya engines exclusively in all sizes until around 2001 when I switched over to OS, only because Enva availability had become so hit and miss due their US importer. My Enya CX45 and 60XF4 were wonderful engines, equal to OS and longer lasting as they were true ABC construction instead of the OS ABN which the plating can peel off the liner easily.

Browsing eBay the other day I stumbled across two new in box Enya 15s, lo and behold one of them is now mine. Not sure what I'll do with it, but nice just to have an example of my first model engine. Maybe I'll finally finish a Midwest Esquire, that combination would make for a nice flying little model.

Most of you know Don Green from his many years in the AGS. Don contacted me recently wanting to get rid of all of his RC stuff and thought some of us in the AGS could get some use from the items he had left.

I will be bringing some items from Don to the New Year's Day Fly - first come first served. I'll also bring any remaining items and offer them up at the next club meeting – incentive for all to attend January meeting!

One item is an Airtronics VG600 radio on channel 39 (72 MHz) with two 7 channel receivers. Radio looks to be in very nice shape, though with any radio of that age I would recommend replacing the transmitter battery.

There are also several chargers and other electronic gadgets I'm hoping someone can use, plus a flight box and transmitter case and few other items.

Finally, we're looking for someone to do a program for the February meeting. Any aviation related topic would be welcome.

## January Meeting Program – by Bob Noll


