Build Updates: by Scott Wallace

My RCM Trainer Jr. is covered and ready for the painting process. I will brush on 6 coats of nitrate, one per day, sanded after every other coat. That is followed by assembling the tail group and doing the fillets with Superfill. Then I'll spray silver dope, address any blemishes, respray and repeat as needed. Then the base color and trim colors are sprayed. After that I wait one week and apply any decals (shout out to Callie graphics – the best!) and finally the clear coat w/ a 2-part rattle can clear urethane. Labor intensive for sure and costly, costs as much or more to finish a model this way as the model itself costs...oh well it's a hobby and it is fun to be old school.
