I finished my Eclipson Model A and maidened it at the Binghamton Aeros field. It flew great with hardly any trim at all. Jeff H. helped out with a few hand launches, a battery pack, and a few last-minute upgrades (I always forget the battery Velcro!).

I'm quite happy with this aircraft. It flies well on a FliteTest PowerPack B, and the prefoamed Polymaker LW-PLA brings the weight down to 550 grams ready-to-fly. I may look into reinforcing the belly with some gaffer's tape in the future – a gust caught me by surprise just as I was landing so I touched down a bit harder than I was planning on.
